Project Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Methodology and approach <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Decompose the whole project into multiple components - Explain the functions of each component and how you would tackle each component • Thesis timeline – for next two terms (term for those doing both Thesis A and Thesis B in one term) • Justification of time allocation for each component • Required training and upskilling identified 	20%	5-7
Project Dependent Preparations	<p>Can the student achieve the aims in the timeline for Thesis B and Thesis C?
